- **If you are staying the night before you must attend the Trail Guide training @ 6:15pm Vandervort Auditorium**
- Meet at the **Vandervort Auditorium** at 7:00 AM for orientation.
- Count teams and students to be sure that there are no extras or alternates with the competing teams.
- Lead students to the test site.
- Assist in handing out and collecting tests.
- Keep teams separate to keep them from overhearing one another.
- There should be no teachers/advisors with their teams.
- No video cameras, cell phones, iPods, tape recorders, or reproducing the tests is allowed by students.
- **Guides may not use electronic devices including cell phones during the competition.**
- Keep the group together while moving between stations. One Guide at the beginning and one at the rear.
- Students needing to use the facilities should be accompanied by a guide.
- All guides will be moving from station to station with the same group of teams.
- On the sign in sheet, you will see what category you are to begin with.
 - For example, if you are **Mover F**, you will start at **Forestry** and move with your group through the competition rotation.
